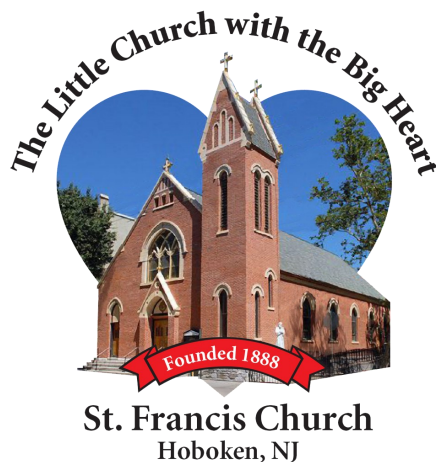

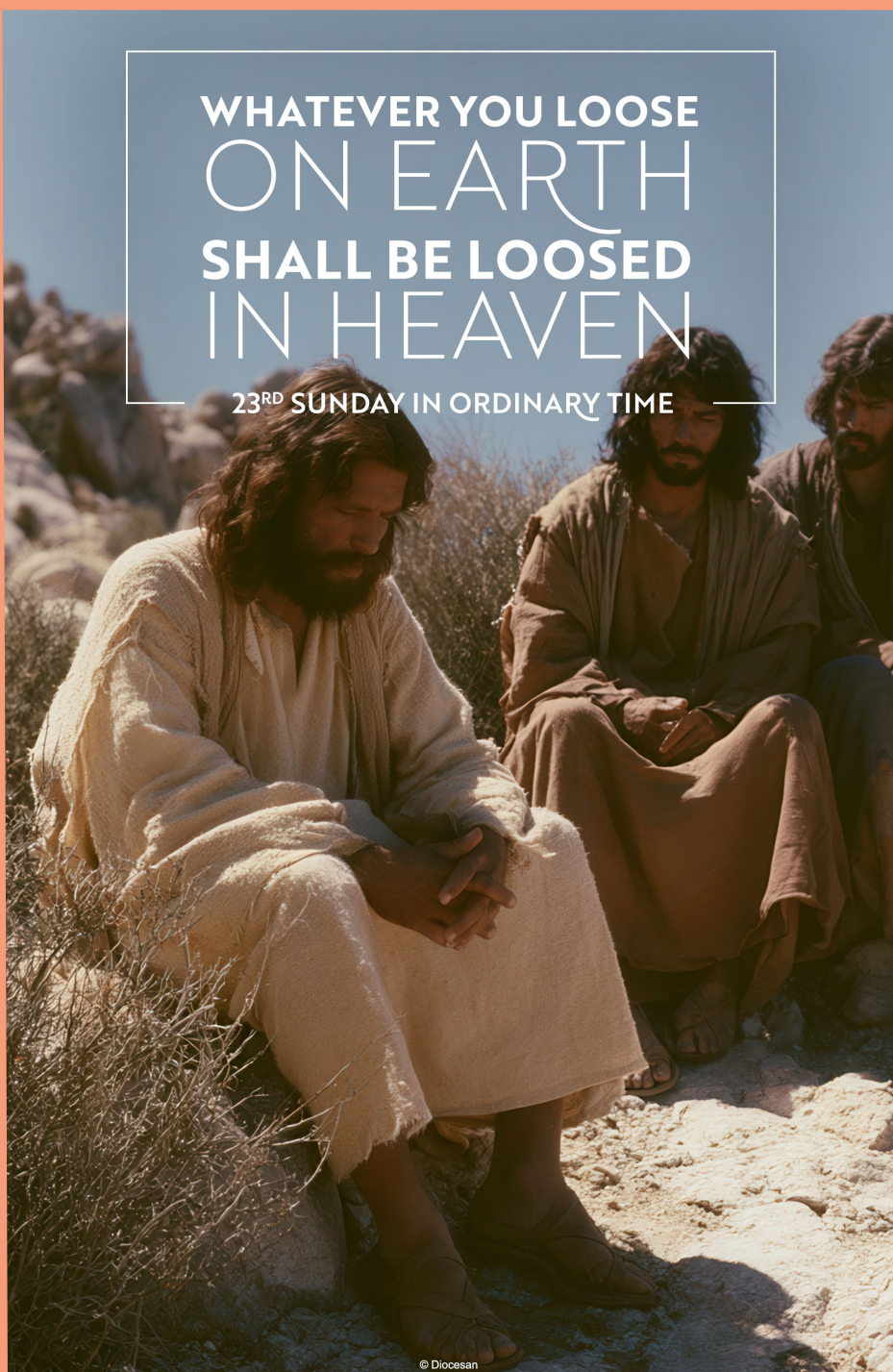

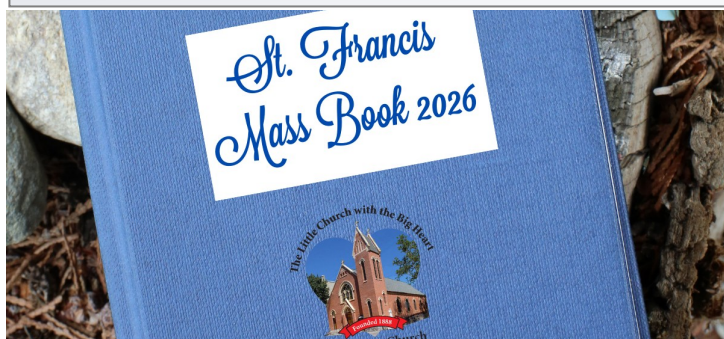

MADONNA DEI MARTIRI FESTIVITIES — Please note an important update regarding the 100th celebration of the Feast of the Madonna dei Martiri. To commemorate the Centennial Celebration, the Novena Mass on Tuesday September 8, will now be held at St. Ann Church, 704 Jefferson St. St. Ann was the original church that gave birth to this tradition and the Devotees of the Madonna Society would like to recognize the parish for that kind gesture. Like the masses at St. Francis, the mass on Sept. 8 will open with the rosary at 6:45 PM followed by mass at 7:30 which will be celebrated by Fathers Don Ignazio Pansini & Fr. Joe Scarengella.
